Loose plastic bags of any kind cause issues for the mechanical equipment used for sorting at the Recycling Facility. Please place your cart out by 6:00 am for pick-up.

^bPlace reusable shoes and clothing in sealed plastic bag and label "linens". Place on top of recycling cart.

^cBoxboard includes boxes from cereal, cracker, toothpaste, and similar items.

^dIncludes laundry, toys, kitty litter pails and buckets.
