



**Notice of Election
Presidential Nomination Primary
City of North Saint Paul
Ramsey County, State of Minnesota**

Notice is hereby given that a presidential nomination primary will be conducted in Minnesota on Mar. 3, 2020. The hours of voting for all locations will be 7 a.m. to 8 p.m. The two participating major parties will have separate party ballots for the presidential nomination primary; voters must choose one of the party ballots in order to vote. Polling place election judges must record the name of the major political party whose ballot the voter requested in the polling place roster. The major political party ballot selected by a nomination primary voter is private data, but it must be shared with the chairs of the major political parties in the State of Minnesota.

The two participating major parties in the presidential nomination primary are:

Democratic-Farmer-Labor Party
Republican Party
